The Bibles are a lifeline to Christians who cannot meet in churches.	<b>10</b> Steve Moore has temporarily traded in his supervisory duties in Production for supervising (and loving!) his two children at home during his parental leave. Our Corporation members are a huge blessing to Galcom!	<b>17</b> Pray for Batjargal Tuvshint-sengel of WIND FM in Mongolia. They have a dream of providing 15000 radios so families can tune in to church services and teaching programs as they continue to struggle through lock-down conditions.	<b>18</b> Voice of the Martyrs Niger has received 4000 audio Bibles from Galcom this summer. Pray for safety for their workers as the units are distributed; there is a lot of persecution of Christians here.	<b>19</b> Chris Lane, Galcom volunteer, has been soldering circuit boards from home during our production shut-down. He is very involved with his church and on the pastoral search committee; pray for wisdom as they find a new minister.
<b>20</b> Pray for Mosoj Chaski Radio in Peru as they extend their broadcast day to 12 hours. They have been broadcasting in 2 blocks of 4 hours by shortwave, and are now filling the gap in between with an online stream.	<b>21</b> Jesper Noer, originally from Denmark, has been involved with Galcom for many years since he first joined in on the tower installations in Greenland. **10**

God has enabled us to plant 15 radio stations in Greenland, covering almost the entire population. Please pray that the hearing of God's Word would change lives and that there would be spiritual growth in the hearts of the listeners.

**11**

Lift up Bethel Baptist Church in Strathroy, ON today. They had to cancel their planned trip to Peru for this year, but are encouraged to hear what a lifeline the radios have been which they distributed there in 2019.

**12**

Please pray for our partners at One Tribe, who produce radio programs promoting reconciliation between warring tribes in Africa. They are now doing seed distribution because of UN cuts to refugee food programs.

**13**

Faye Whatford's work in PR has been redirected somewhat because of all the events and conferences that have been cancelled. She has taken advantage of the time to work on new promotional material. Pray for her skill and ability.

**14**

Pray for the planned upgrade of Goré Radio Shi Maj station in Chad, installed in 2017. The station was hit by lightning, and it has taken months to get replacement parts shipped to them.

Dorothy Dickson, faithful Galcom volunteer, has been having tests for some digestive issues. Please pray for her healing and restoration.

Bob & Vivian Sturgeon, our VARs in Quebec, need your prayers. Vivian is struggling with high blood sugar and diabetes. Pray that her new meds are effective so she can avoid insulin shots.
