Long before I joined Galcom, our founder Allan McGuirl was working with pastors and church leaders in Quebec to establish a Christian radio station. His most recent attempt started seven years ago in partnership with Aujourd'hui l'Espoir, a wonderful Christian TV ministry that was the French voice of ministries like *In Touch* with Charles Stanley, *Thru the Bible* with J. Vernon McGee and *Living Truth* with Charles Price. With the support of TWR Canada, they had built up a library of thousands of hours of solid Bible teaching, and were the perfect complement to Galcom's technical radio expertise.

Just as in remote villages in Africa or the islands of Indonesia, the few Christians in Quebec can multiply themselves. This is the power of radio: one person with the right equipment reaching millions! That's right—the population of Quebec is just over eight million with less than 2% evangelical Christians, making the Quebecois officially an unreached people group. There are not enough churches and workers to reach all of these lost people, but radio can!

Throughout the struggle of getting a license, we often wondered why God allowed it to take so long. According to 2 Peter 3:9, "The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as
