Praise God for the thousands of written Bibles Russell Stendal of Colombia Para Cristo has been able to import into Venezuela. Galcom Compass players are next!

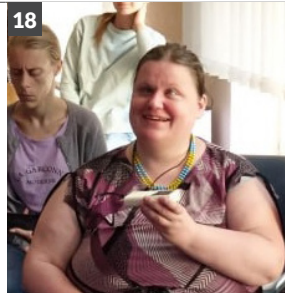
