GOD'S WORD IS NECESSARY FOR THE CHURCH

The Cambodia Community Bible Institute, which is managed by Pastor Mao Yeun, gave a presentation on October 6, 2023 to 25 teachers, leaders, elders, and church members from the congregations in Village 4, Sangkat Dang Tong, which is located in the Khemarak Phoumin Municipality of the Koh Kong Province. The leaders of the churches in that location felt God's touch, and as a result, they established a new Bible study group beginning with session 1 (The Old Testament, New Testament Survey, and Galatians) which had a total of nine participants (six men and three women). Ken Chan Sopheap, the leader of Hanmaim Church in Koh Kong Province, served as the coordinator and primary instructor for the study.



BIBLE COURSES CONTINUED

We give thanks to God for all His guidance. The first-level certificate in The Old Testament and New Testament Survey and Galatians was given out on October 27, 2023 by the Cambodia Community Bible Institute to a total of 40 indigenous graduates, including 16-male and 24-female students from Anlong Village, Sangkat Boeung Kanseng, Banlung City, Ratanakkiri Province. This event took place under the coordination and guidance of Pastor Tith Chandara of the Ratanakkiri Church and Teav Sim of the Banlung Church.



The students honored God by singing songs of praise in their native tongues, which included Tampuan, Kreung, Khmer, and Jarai respectively. The head of Banlung Church, Mr. Thiv Sim, felt that he had a lot of lessons to learn over the course of the three months of study, but he made an effort to read, pay attention to the teacher's explanations from memory, and pray in order to grasp the material. Praise the Lord he was able to answer each question. After the certificates of completion were handed out to the students, 24 students enrolled to get books and MP3 audio lessons for the second semester. There were 15 male students and 9 female students who signed up for the program. All glory and honor be to God!
