# **Good News in the Far North**


n aul Moses, pastor of Waskaganish Cree Gospel Fellowship **L** in northern Quebec, knew that a radio station would be the ideal way to minister to the spread-out people in his area. He reached out to Nations One, who in turn partnered with Galcom to fund and help with the installation. The project

paused through the pandemic, but with the help of some friends and volunteers, the station is now up and on the air. Sibi Ayimuweyabi Radio 92.5 FM often broadcasts in the Cree language, preserving and reviving the culture of this Indigenous people.
