There are frequent teams from Canada delivering radios to the Quechua of Bolivia, tuned to Mosoj Chaski (New Messenger) Radio. Please pray for this Indigenous-led ministry; they often struggle financially.

Last quarter, we asked for prayer regarding a bad batch of batteries. Kruša FM in Cambodia was impacted before we caught the problem. Please pray as they test the radios they've received, and for us as we replace the faulty ones.

Pray for Ron Harris, who provides advice and his voice to our weekly Mission Compass radio show. He also leads MEDIA Alliance, training broadcasters from around the world, and mentors many of our broadcast partners.

15

The Maranao people of the Philippines are known for their beautiful metalwork, textiles, and music. Pray that these artistic people would turn from Islam and put their faith in the master Creator, who cares so much for them.

Southgate Church in Kemptville, ON keeps a stock of Galcom radios to give to church members heading to a creative access country on "vacation". Pray as people share their faith and leave behind a radio as a witness.

Every Village ministers in South Sudan in the most needed ways, including installing and repairing water wells. Rejoice with them as they repaired their 1,000th water well this past summer, and pray for continued access to safe water.

18

Galcom is currently organizing a women's mission trip for May, teaching on the fruit of the Spirit to the Quechua women at Runa Simi in Ayacucho. The team will also bring radios and audio Bibles to the Chosica area of Peru.

Every month, Stan Jeter of the GNA joins our Mission Compass show to share a "God story". He also gives us tips on how to use our cell phones to report what God is doing in our community. Pray for more cell phone evangelists.

The Mutrux family is still fostering the little boy they have had since his birth. He is now three years old and has made impressive progress from his initial condition. Pray for God's wonderful plans for his future.

Mission Aviation Fellowship is a growing partner of Galcom's. MAF pilots deliver radios regularly to South Sudan. We are now discussing further outreaches around the world. Pray for the impact of rising fuel costs.

The 100,000 Wala people in Ghana traditionally follow an animistic religion of worshipping their ancestors' spirits and believe they will become evil if not appeased. Pray for freedom from the bondage and fear these beliefs cause.

The National Religious Broadcasters' Convention is underway! Pray for the Galcom team as they meet the staff from partnering agencies, reconnect, and plan Compass orders and radio-station builds for the upcoming year.

Please pray for IBRA Radio, our partners in Mozambique. Unrest in the country and corruption in the Customs department has delayed getting any more Compass radios to them. They are desperate for more!

Don Middleton, Galcom VAR, helped man our booth at Seattle Missions Fest this past September. He is thankful for the good connections made as he shared about the exciting things God is doing through Galcom.

27

All of our radio partners in Albania have received letters from the government threatening their licenses unless they change their content. Pray for wisdom, and for God to "change the heart of the king".

28

Pray for 930 AM The Light, broadcasting from Edmonton, Alberta. They air our weekly Mission Compass program, and we even had two members join us on a trip to Peru because they heard us on The Light!
