**Persecution Project, Sudan**  
**19,000 players since 2022**  
Audio Bibles were distributed alongside other emergency relief supplies to refugees. The recipient families returned to their Nuba homeland with very few personal possessions, so to have access to the Word of God once again is a treasure they deeply cherish.



**FEBC**  
**26,000 players since 2022**  
FEBC's Krusa FM in Cambodia delivered help and hope to soldiers on the front lines there. The team distributed 250 audio players and food supplies to grateful military officers, police, and border guards.



**Runa Simi, Peru**  
**5 mission trips with Galcom since 2019**  
In March of this year, Galcom and Runa Simi hosted a trip to visit prisons in Peru for the first time. The prisoners have very little; this man wept with joy to receive something as precious as a Compass player.



**PSGL & High Adventure**  
**19,300 players since 2013**  
This is Betty, a former abductee of the LRA (a Ugandan extremist terrorist group) who was captured from her school and spent three years in captivity. She made her escape, and now serves in Bidibidi Refugee Camp as a nurse.
