










| 1 KARI Radio airs on 550 AM in the Washington state area, and is the only all-Bible teaching and Christian talk-radio station that reaches the Greater Vancouver area. Mission Compass can be heard here on Sundays at 3:30 PM PST. | 2 Promise Radio in Karagwe was the fourth in a series of radio stations we installed in Tanzania. They have struggled through government interference and technical issues. Pray they maintain a strong Gospel message. | 3 Brent Geertsema, our Media Promotions Coordinator, now lives far from his family in Chesterville, which is near Ottawa, ON. Pray that he will have more opportunities to visit and reconnect with his family back home. | 4 Pray for Waldo Navarro, the Director of Mosoj Chaski Radio. We recently received a testimony from a listener to an old Go-Ye radio. But without the broadcast, the receivers are useless. Pray that God provides for their needs. | 5 Galcom has partnered with the Native Evangelical Fellowship of Canada on several radio stations on First Nations territories over the past year. Pray for a breakthrough on a planned installation in Cambridge Bay, Nunavut. | 6 We are currently fundraising for two repeater stations for Radio Uhai in Tabora, Tanzania. Both need solar arrays to power the stations. Pray for the team waiting to connect with hundreds of thousands of new listeners. | 7 The Vai people of Liberia have a secret society called the Poro that rules every aspect of their lives and places taboos on anything or anybody, and the people will die rather than violate them. Pray they will learn of the freedom Christ brings. |
| 8  | 9 To honour our co-founder, Ken Crowell, we have a legacy project in Ghana ministering to an unreached people group. Pray for the tower currently en route to complete an upgrade of stations operated by Theovision, our partner. | 10 Theovision was founded by Theo Asare, recording audio Bibles for oral people groups throughout West Africa. Pray for his son Philip, who took over in October. They have a network of radio stations and offices in Ghana and Kenya. | 11 Louise Claros, Galcom VAR, lives in Gatineau, QC, but spends much of her time in Sarnia, ON, with her daughter Isabelle. She asks for prayer that her daughter recognizes her need for a Saviour. | 12 Galcom built Solwezi FCC Radio in Zambia in 2009 for Elisha Kyanamina, who passed away earlier this year. Please pray for his daughter, Besa, who has taken over leadership of the radio station and ministry. | 13 A small order of a few hundred Compasses is en route to Pastor Tsepiso of Lesotho. They travel through England and South Africa before being carried in. Pray for smooth travel and that the radios reach the right people. | 14  |
| 15 KFM Positive and Encouraging Radio has 14 stations across Northern Ontario airing the Mission Compass show, all on Sundays at 8:30 AM EST. Pray that listeners will tune in and discover their role in the Great Commission! | 16 Pray for the outreach of Radio Bendición Divina. Galcom is currently assisting with the funds for a new transmitter in Puquio, Peru. It is in a remote area and will provide inspiration for many people who don't read or write. | 17 Faye Whatford would ask you to pray for her mother, Edna Hart, who suffered a stroke this past autumn and is currently recovering with physical therapy. It has been a challenging journey for this active woman. | 18 Pray for Radio 4VEH's Lisa DeGraaf. She is officially a Galcom employee, but we have seconded her to 4VEH to help with administrative and financial matters. Work in Haiti is always difficult; pray for wisdom and grace. | 19 Martie van Niekerk, our Production Administrator, delights in her two young granddaughters, Allie and Keira. Pray that they would come to know and follow the Lord. | 20 The issues with international shipping persist as countries impose tariffs and others respond with retaliatory measures. It is shipments like ours that get caught in the tug of war. Pray for favour over our radios. | 21 The Dayak people in Indonesia speak more than 170 languages and dialects. They need protection for their land, which is a magnet for unscrupulous, often illegal logging companies. Pray for the 2% of believers among them. |
