get to share with you. So, this month, instead of a longer report on one project or following a theme, we have a potpourri of updates.

This coming year, we hope to build more radios, work on more radio stations, and go on more short-term mission trips to distribute radios than any previous year in our history. But to accomplish that, we need your prayers. Here are a couple of requests to get you started.

Pray for the completion of our Compass model 2.0. We have only been making our new Compass player for a couple of years, and we already need to make significant changes to components on the circuit board and switch to a USB-C port for loading audio content and optional charging (the solar panel is still the best way to charge the players). The player also needs certifications to make exporting easier. Pray for our R&D and production teams as they collaborate with suppliers and consultants on this work.




SUDAN


